Q: Hard squashes are packed with sweet flavor and hearty texture. Which is your favorite and how do you serve it?

A: I have just really been discovering hard squash in the last couple of years, from pumpkin risotto with fresh Hubbard squash, to roasted spaghetti squash used to lighten up a dish, or tempura-fried Delicata squash. My favorite is a sweet, earthy apple and butternut squash soup. Delicious topped with a crab or crayfish hushpuppy.

- Roasted Butternut cubes add seasonal colors and a hint of sweetness to kale and arugula salads.
- Bake Acorn squash halves with miso and butter; slice and serve with fish.
- Drop tender chunks of roasted Delicata squash into bean- or rice-based soups.
