Q: Winter salads are heartier and use different ingredients such as ancient grains, root vegetables, and nuts. What are your favorite seasonal recipes?

A: I am really into roasted seasonal vegetables with or without the addition of grains. Try roasting red onions, Butternut squash, baby red potatoes, carrots, and parsnips with olive oil and sea salt; toss with Ready-Set-Serve® (RSS) Urban Blend, Feta cheese, and balsamic vinaigrette.

- Toss red quinoa and roasted Delicata squash rings with leafy RSS Spring Mix; toss with pomegranate vinaigrette and toasted almonds.

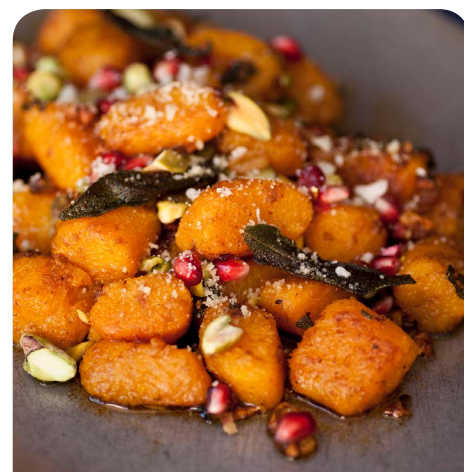
