Highlights

- Mildew, internal burn, and fringe burn are industry-wide problems in lettuces due to recent inclement weather.
- President Trump announced the U.S. would be imposing tariffs on all Mexican imports effective June 10 if illegal immigration from Mexico did not subside, starting at 5% on June 10, to 10% on July 1, and an additional 5% on the first day of each subsequent month for three months until reaching 25 percent.
- The bulk of Markon First Crop® (MFC) Strawberry orders will be shipped out of the Salinas/Watsonville region now that supplies have increased and quality is improving.

Q: Fresh berries add color, texture, and sweetness—how do you use them?

A: I macerate fresh berries with a fortified wine such as port or madeira, palm sugar, vanilla, and Ready-Set-Serve® (RSS) Lemon Juice to bring out their flavor and force the juice from the berries into the maceration. Allow to set for a few hours, strain, take $\frac{3}{4}$ of liquid into a hot saucepan with sherry vinegar and cook to a gastrique state. With the remaining macerated juice, add heavy cream and egg yolks then temper over a water bath to make a sabayon. Build parfaits with layers of berries and sabayon with drizzled gastrique throughout the glass. Chill before service. Garnish with chopped MFC Strawberries, blackberries, blueberries, and raspberries.
