**Q:** Fennel is an ideal grilling vegetable. Describe how you like to serve it during the summer months. Which sauces/pairings you suggest?

A: The mild licorice flavor of fennel gets a complex smokiness when cooked on the grill. My favorite way to serve this is with seafood, especially scallops and mild fish. I like to take it off the grill before it's soft and serve al dente style.

- Shave thin slices of MFC Fennel; toss with Ready-Set-Serve® (RSS) Brussels Sprouts Halves and citrusy vinaigrette.
