## Highlights

- Markon First Crop® (MFC) Premium Green Leaf weights are higher on average than the rest of the industry (23 to 26 pounds compared with 19 to 24 pounds).
- Rain and low desert region temperatures are causing lettuce ice and harvesting delays that may result in quality issues down the road.
- The Mexican and offshore cantaloupe and honeydew melon seasons are underway; supplies are increasing.
- Rain has reduced strawberry volume and driven up prices. Another storm is forecast for next week, further reducing stocks and affecting quality.

**A:** I call baby broccoli “the gateway” produce item. It allows you to explore other great produce inspired dishes. One of my favorites is the simplest, oven roasted with a slight hint of charring, garnished with fresh lemon zest, and earthy Parmesan cheese.

- Roast with MFC Mushrooms and serve on top of polenta.
- Bake with MFC Potatoes in a creamy gratin to add color and texture.
- Sear, chop, and add to omelets and scrambled egg dishes.
- Lightly steam until al dente; serve with radishes, baby carrots, and dips such as French onion, hummus, or baba ghanouj.

## Produce Highlights

### Broccoli

- Markets are expected to remain at mid-levels over the next 7 to 10 days.
- Cold weather forecast in the desert region this week will slow growth.

### Brussels Sprouts

- Prices are active due to strong demand and limited supplies.
- Current size profile is dominated by small and medium; jumbo sizes are extremely limited.

### Celery

- The market is rising.
- Prices will remain active until holiday demand subsides and production ramps up in Florida and Yuma, Arizona.

## Apples

Prices are stable. Washington MFC Fuji, Gala, Golden Delicious, Granny Smith, and Red Delicious Apples are ample, especially 88- to 113-count sizes. Quality is excellent: sugar levels range from 12 to 14 Brix.

The market is up; holiday demand is strong. Stocks are tightening in Mexico and Peru (into Miami, Florida). Expect high prices through January. Quality is very good: tips are firm, color is bright, and flavor is grassy. MFC Asparagus is available.

Prices are steady; supplies are sufficient. All sizes are available; 48-, 60-, and 70-count sizes are most abundant. Quality is very good: texture is creamy and flavor is nutty. RSS Avocado Chunks, Halves, Pico de Gallo Guacamole, and Pure Pulp are on the market.

## Bells: Green

Markets for all sizes continue to inch up; 70- to 100-count supplies will remain tight through December. 2021 crop yields are down by 15-20% in the Pacific Northwest (Idaho, Oregon, and Washington). Limited supplies are forecast through the rest of the season (July 2022). U.S. No. 2 stocks are tight.

## Raspberries

Prices are unchanged. Expect sufficient volume through the end of the year. Quality is very good: berries are plump and sweet.
