- Lime supplies remain extremely limited; Markets are climbing.

FEATURED QUESTION

Q: Asparagus is a symbol of spring. What are some original ways you use it on your menus?

A: One of the most successful asparagus items on the menu when I worked at celebrity chef Waldy Malouf's Beacon in NYC was an asparagus and egg. We would take a non-stick pan and sauté the peeled asparagus, add an egg then top with toasted panko, lemon zest, Parmesan cheese, fresh herbs, and finish in our wood-fired oven.

- Lightly fry MFC Asparagus in buttermilk and panko breadcrumbs; serve with spicy wasabi dipping sauce.
- Wrap spears of MFC Asparagus in thinly sliced pancetta; grill until meat is crisp and asparagus is tender.
- Sauté MFC Asparagus, fresh morels, and shallots; serve over polenta with snipped MFC Chives.

Tips for Serving Red Potatoes

- Combine boiled and chopped red potatoes, cherry tomatoes, corn, green beans, and minced shallots; stir-in basil mayonnaise and serve with sandwiches and burgers.
- Toss boiled and chopped red potatoes with melted butter and chopped tarragon; serve with grilled or steamed fish.
- Thread boiled red potatoes and fennel slices on skewers; slather with Dijon mustard and grill.

Apples

Prices are low. Washington MFC Fuji, Gala, Golden Delicious, Granny Smith, and Red Delicious Apples are available; storage supplies are dominated by 88- to 113-count sizes. Quality is excellent: sugar levels range from 12 to 14 Brix.

The market is inching down; supplies have increased slightly. Quality is very good: spear and tips are firm, color is bright, and flavor is grassy. MFC Asparagus is available.

Prices are stable to slightly higher. Mexican supplies are sufficient in Sinaloa; production in Sonora is starting to rebound as weather warms. All sizes and grades are available. MFC and Markon Essentials® (ESS) Green Bell Peppers are available; packer label is being substituted as necessary.

Prices are fairly steady. Mexican stocks are sufficient. Production has begun in Oxnard, California and will increase through the month. Quality is very good: berries are plump and juicy with deep purple color.

The market is high. Mexican stocks are limited but will increase once spring harvesting ramps up. Delays at ports and unloading challenges persist. Quality is very good: flavor is sweet with pleasantly tangy undertones.

The market is steady; Mexican and offshore stocks are meeting demand. Quality is very good: sugar levels range between 10 and 14 Brix.

Prices are inching up; supplies are tightening due to erratic weather. Quality is very good: color is snowy white and size is consistent. ESS Cauliflower is available.

The market is a bit higher; the Arizona/California season is wrapping up. The Oxnard season will run through June. Quality is excellent. MFC Celery is available.

Prices are rising. Yields are low due to inconsistent weather; low weights, small size, and fluctuating densities are affecting lots throughout the industry. MFC Premium Iceberg Lettuce is sporadic; Markon Best Available is being packed as needed.

High prices will persist through late March. Mexican volume is at its seasonal low. Limited supplies of offshore limes are in the marketplace. MFC and ESS Limes are sporadic; packer label substituted when necessary.

Prices remain elevated. Northwest storage stocks will be depleted sooner than normal. Overall quality is very good; however, occasional internal defects include translucency, dryness, and watery scale. Texas-grown and Mexican fresh-run yellow onions (crossing into South Texas) are limited but will increase as these seasons progress; red onions will enter the market next week. California stocks will become available from the Imperial Valley in mid-April. The New Mexico season will begin in early June. MFC Red and Yellow Onions are available.

The market is stable. The Navel crop is dominated by large sizes (56- to 88-count packs); smaller sizes (113- and 138-count) are tightening. Sugar levels range from 10 to 13 Brix. MFC Navel Oranges are available.

Idaho Burbank and Norkotah prices are elevated. The remaining crop is dominated by large sizes (40- and 50-count potatoes); smaller sizes (80- to 100-count stocks) are sufficient. Norkotahs will remain on the market into early April; once depleted, Burbanks will be shipped through the rest of the season. MFC Burbank and Norkotah Potatoes are available.

The market is steady to slightly higher. Supplies are average. Quality is very good: berries are plump, deep red, and tangy sweet.

Romaine

Expect elevated prices for the next 10 days. Quality is average: freeze-related blistering/peeling and fringe/internal burn are prevalent. Industry supplies are forecast to increase in two to three weeks, pending weather. MFC Premium Romaine Lettuce is sporadic; MBA is being substituted as necessary due to low weights.

Markets for raw product iceberg and romaine are climbing; volume is low. Low weights mean it takes more heads to reach needed volume. Markon's Quality Assurance team continues to monitor quality and processing for the best packs.

Prices are steady; Arizona/California desert supplies are adequate. Quality is very good: yellowing is minimal. RSS Conventional and Organic Spring Mixes are available.
