Highlights

Q: Eggplant is a versatile ingredient that can be fried, baked, roasted/pureed...how do you showcase it?

A: My favorite eggplant dish is Sicilian caponata, a vegetable stew that combines roasted eggplant, red bell peppers, onions, garlic, tomatoes, capers, and olives. It can be served as a side dish, under lamb chops, or served with crostini as an appetizer or bar snack.

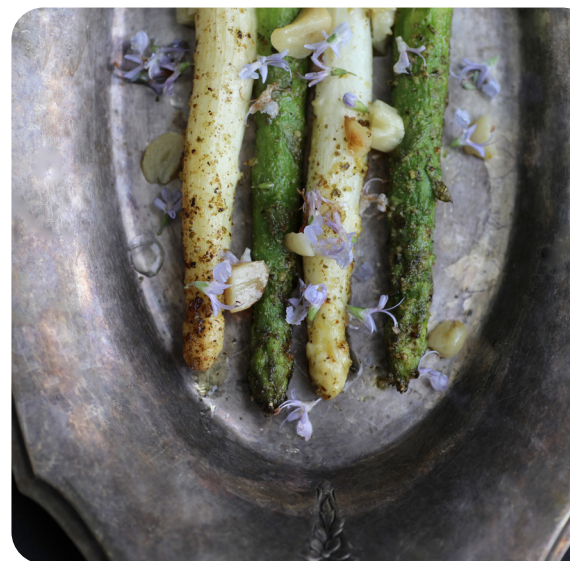
- Eggplant parmigiana is a rich, cheesy dish that appeals to vegetarians and meat lovers alike.
- Greek moussaka combines eggplant, ground beef, garlic, onions, and tomatoes. Top with a decadent bechamel sauce and bake until bubbly.
- Levantine baba ghanoush can be a partner or substitute to hummus dips. Puree roasted eggplant with lemon juice, olive oil, garlic, and salt; serve with dipping bread or raw vegetables.

Cauliflower

- Volume remains low, keeping prices elevated.
- Expect markets to ease when the Salinas, California season ramps up.

Celery

- Prices remain fairly elevated.
- The Arizona/California desert season is winding down, shifting demand to Oxnard and Santa Maria, California.

Limes

- Expect high markets and limited Mexican supplies into mid-April.
- Very small sizes (250- and 275-count fruit) are becoming more prevalent.

The market is level. Washington MFC Fuji, Gala, Golden Delicious, Granny Smith, and Red Delicious Apples are available; 88- to 113-count sizes dominate storage supplies. Quality is excellent: sugar levels range from 12 to 14 Brix.

Prices are weak. Mexican stocks are abundant. Peruvian imports will remain tight through early April. Quality is very good: spear and tips are firm, color is bright, and flavor is grassy. MFC Asparagus is available.

The market is steady. Mexican supplies are dominated by 48-count and larger sizes. Quality is very good. RSS Avocado Chunks, Halves, Pico de Gallo Guacamole, and Pure Pulp are on the market.

Green bell prices are slightly lower; demand is moderate. Florida stocks are tight due to the early February freezing conditions which caused bloom drop; volume will rise in mid-April. Between lower production from older plants and a good chunk of product being harvested at the green stage to capitalize on the hot green bell market, red bell pepper availability is lighter. Canada's season is off to a good start; volume will gradually rise. MFC and Markon Essentials® (ESS) Green and Red Bell Peppers are available.

The Salinas season will begin in early to mid-April. MFC Premium Romaine Lettuce is sporadic; MBA is being substituted as necessary due to low weights.
