Highlights

- Markon First Crop® (MFC) Premium Romaine weights are higher on average than the rest of the industry (36 to 40 pounds compared with 29 to 36 pounds).
- The AZ/CA desert lettuce growing region experienced three separate heat spikes throughout March, yet Markon inspectors have not observed as many serious heat-related defects as expected. Sun scalding and sunburn are sporadic issues as well as varying amounts of insect pressure in commodity and lightly prepped value-added items.
- Expect green bell pepper prices to remain elevated over the next two weeks; red bell markets will hold steady.

- Expect slightly lower prices as growers continue to transition from the Arizona/California desert to the Salinas Valley.
- Desert supplies will be depleted by mid-April.

Strawberries

- Expect strong markets and tight supplies over the next 7-10 days.
- Recent California rain curtailed harvesting and lowered volume.

Apples

Prices are unchanged. Washington MFC Fuji, Gala, Golden Delicious, Granny Smith, and Red Delicious Apples are on the market; 88- to 113-count sizes dominate storage stocks. Quality is excellent: sugar levels range from 12 to 14 Brix.

The market is beginning to inch up as the season in Caborca, Mexico winds down. Production will start in Central Mexico in mid-April. Although Peruvian imports are increasing, overall volume remains low. Quality is very good: spear and tips are firm, color is bright, and flavor is grassy. MFC Asparagus is available.

MFC and Markon Essentials® (ESS) Green and Red Bell Peppers are available.
