Markon First Crop® (MFC)

MFC Premium Romaine weights are higher on average than the rest of the industry (36 to 38 pounds compared with 29 to 36 pounds).

California Strawberries

Expect volume to continue declining through July as the Salinas/Watsonville season has moved past peak production.

Seeder in Salinas Valley Lettuce Crops

Unseasonably warm and humid weather in June and early July has caused many lettuce crops to develop seeder/long core. Markon inspectors have mostly been able to avoid seeder concerns for Markon First Crop commodity packs. Value-added processors have had a hard time eliminating core from incoming raw product and finished packs.

BELL PEPPERS

- Overall green bell pepper stocks are tightening due to harvesting transitions.
- Red bell pepper supplies are increasing in California; markets are slowly decreasing.

ZUCCHINI

- Stocks are being harvested in multiple East Coast regions, including Michigan, New Jersey, and Virginia.
- West Coast growers are packing out of Fresno, Santa Maria, and Watsonville, California as well as Baja, Mexico.

POTATOES

- Remaining storage supplies are extremely limited in Idaho, Oregon, and Washington.
- Washington supplies are expected to be depleted in this week. Prices will continue to climb.

MFC Washington Fuji, Granny Smith, Gold Delicious, and Red Delicious apples are readily available. Sizes are dominated by 88- to 113- count fruit. Remaining MFC Gala Apples supplies are limited. The California Gala Apple season will start next week. Quality is excellent: sugar levels are in the 12 to 14 Brix range.

Q

Fennel is an ideal grilling vegetable. Describe how you like to serve it during the summer months. Which sauces/pairings you suggest?

A

Fennel is extremely versatile. When raw, it has a strong anise or licorice flavor; however, a soft grilling, freshly grated Reggiano cheese and lemon transform this Mediterranean staple into a delicious side dish for steaks and fish.



Toss raw, shaved MFC Fennel with thick slices of MFC Tomato, crispy bacon, and blue cheese.



Throw sliced MFC Fennel on the grill or flat top and cook until charred; drizzle with dressing made with Kalamata olives, garlic, and basil.

TIPS FOR SERVING FENNEL:



- 1.** Shave raw MFC Fennel into green salads; add their fronds to salad dressing or use as a garnish.
- 2.** Fennel pairs well with onions, citrus, poultry and sausages, cheese, and apples.
- 3.** Give roasted meats and poultry the subtle anise flavor that fennel develops as it cooks.

Every chef needs a few solid recipes in his or her repertoire. That's why Markon has put together a catalog of fresh produce-based recipes that cover it all: day- and menu-parts, the range of seasons, a variety of cuisines, and a diverse list of ingredients.

Fennel-Brussels Sprouts Salad

A great alternative to lettuce-based salads, this dish combines the earthiness of Brussels sprouts with the licorice-like flavors of fennel. Dress with a bright, citrusy vinaigrette and serve solo or with roasted poultry.

- 2 Markon First Crop Fennel bulbs, shaved (reserve fronds)
- 1 lb. Ready-Set-Serve Brussels Sprouts, shaved
- ½ C citrus vinaigrette
- Edible flowers as garnish, if desired

Toss shaved fennel and sprouts with citrus vinaigrette.

Arrange on large serving platter and garnish with fennel fronds and edible flowers. Serve.

Grilling sweet stone fruits such as peaches and plums brings out a deep, smoky sweetness—a perfect complement to the creamy, saltiness of fresh Burrata.
