HIGHLIGHTS

FALL HARVESTING TRANSITION

Arizona/California desert lettuce production is underway, with additional growers beginning harvest next week. Iceberg markets are moderately elevated but will inch down as supplies increase and Thanksgiving holiday demand subsides. Green leaf and romaine prices will remain fairly steady in the coming weeks.

ARTICHOKES

Supplies are extremely limited; small and medium sizes (18through 36-count packs) are tight. Expect light volume and

CARROTS

Expect elevated commodity markets and tight supplies through December. RSS Carrots will meet demand; prices will hold steady.



BELL PEPPERS

- Prices are active; harvesting transitions are underway on both coasts.
- Strong demand for Thanksgiving will further increase markets over the next week.

GREEN BEANS

- The market remains high; supplies are extremely limited due
- RSS Trimmed Green Beans are limited.

SUGAR SNAP PEAS

- Supplies are limited due to industry-wide quality challenges, reducing harvestable yields.

MFC and ESS Green and Red Bell Peppers are available.

MFC Broccoli Crowns are sporadic; Markon Best Available (MBA) and packer label will be substituted when supplies don't meet our specifications.

Modern diners are crazy for crunch, especially when combined with gooey cheese or silky guacamole. I like serving house-made tortilla chips with two dips: RSS Pico de Gallo Guacamole and spicy Jalapeño queso.



Use contrasting textures like tender rice and creamy RSS Avocado Halves with crispy fried chicken chunks. MFC Cucumbers. and watermelon radish slices.



Serve on-trend dips such as hummus and spinach artichoke with crunchy baked pita chips.












TIPS FOR SERVING POTATOES:



- Cut skin-on MFC Potatoes into shoestring strips; deep fry and serve with garlicky aioli and chopped RSS Italian Parsley.
- Boil MFC Potatoes and parsnips; mash with olive oil, cream, and finely minced MFC Sage.
- Toss thinly sliced MFC Potatoes with olive oil, salt, and chopped RSS Peeled Garlic; bake until crisp. Serve chips with curry-lime yogurt dip.

Every chef needs a few solid recipes in his or her repertoire. That's why Markon has put together a catalog of fresh produce-based recipes that cover it all: day- and menu-parts, the range of seasons, a variety of cuisines, and a diverse list of ingredients.

Stuffed Turkey with Ready-Set-Serve Urban Blend

1 Tbsp. olive oil

1/2 cup Ready-Set-Serve Diced Yellow Onions 1 Tbsp. Ready-Set-Serve Peeled Garlic, minced

1 Tbsp. zest of Markon First Crop Lemons

3 cups Ready-Set-Serve Urban Blend

2 cups cornbread, crumbled

2 lb. turkey breast, deboned and pounded flat

Salt and pepper, to taste

Preheat oven to 400° F.

Heat oil in a large skillet. Add onions, garlic, and zest; saute until soft. Stir in RSS Urban Blend and cook until wilted (one to two more minutes). Put mixture in food processor along with cornbread and pulse until ground.

Pat turkey dry; score the top with a knife. Season with salt and pepper. Spread RSS Urban Blend mixture over surface of turkey, leaving edges clear. Starting at the bottom, carefully roll the meat into a log-like form. Tuck the ends under and tie the roast with butcher's string. Brush all with any remaining oil from skillet and season with salt and pepper. Cook for 45 minutes or until a thermometer reads 160° F. Slice and serve with mashed sweet potatoes or yams.
