#### **LETTUCES**

Green leaf, iceberg, and romaine lettuce markets are lower; quality has improved, increasing supplies in the Salinas Valley.

#### **ASPARAGUS**

Prices are elevated but steady amid weaker demand as fewer fields are available in Mexico's Caborca region. Domestic growers in the Pacific Northwest and Michigan are harvesting as well.

#### **GRAPES**

The Chilean/Peruvian offshore season will end next week. Grape shipments will transition to Mexican-grown product in mid- to late May, Expect markets to rise as the offshore season continues to wind down.



#### **BELL PEPPERS**

- Green bell peppers are abundant with supply available in multiple growing regions.
- · Markets are low.

#### LIMES

- Prices are down a bit now that Cinco de Mayo demand has subsided.
- Current supplies are dominated by small, 200- to 250-count sizes: larger fruit (110- and 150-count sizes) remains limited.

#### **STRAWBERRIES**

- Clear, warm weather has aided growth in the Santa Maria, Oxnard, and Salinas/Watsonville growing regions.
- Supplies are abundant and markets are steady.


# ASKA MARKON CHEF

Collard greens have been traditionally associated with the American South but are also featured in many global and fusion dishes. How do you like to use RSS Chopped Collard Greens on the menu?



The basic collard recipe I always use consists of sautéed onion, garlic, pepper flakes, cider vinegar, sugar, chicken stock smoked turkey leg, RSS Chopped Collard Greens, and bacon, I also like to sauté these nutrient-dense ingredients in butter with garlic, shallots, salt, pepper, and a squeeze of fresh lemon.

# **Banh Mi**

With its blend of French and Vietnamese cuisine, this delicious sandwich is accessible to most menus.

1 lb. ground pork

1 egg

1/4 cup panko breadcrumbs

1 Tbsp. fish sauce

1 Tbsp. Asian hot sauce

1 Tbsp. RSS Peeled Garlic, chopped

2 Tbsp. canola oil

1/4 cup sov sauce

4 French baguette rolls, split

1 cup RSS Matchstick Carrots, pickled

1/4 cup RSS Washed & Trimmed Green Onions, chopped

1/4 cup RSS Washed & Trimmed Cilantro

3 MFC Jalapeno Chile Peppers, sliced

4 RSS Green Leaf Fillets

Combine pork, egg, breadcrumbs, fish sauce, hot sauce, and garlic. Form into 12 small balls. Brown meatballs in hot oil. When all are nearly cooked through. deglaze with soy sauce, shaking pan to coat all. Turn off heat, cover skillet with lid, and allow to steam for three more minutes. Fill each baguette roll with three meatballs, pickled carrots, green onions, cilantro, Jalapeno chile peppers, and green leaf lettuce.
