HIGHLIGHTS

CILANTRO

Production has slowed, causing markets to rise. Though crops have seen dry and relatively mild temperatures since early May, persistent cloud cover is slowing maturity.

STRAWBERRIES

Warm, sunny weather is increasing supplies and improving quality in the Oxnard, Santa Maria, and Salinas/Watsonville, California growing regions. Prices are easing.

CAULIFLOWER

Volume is escalating in the Salinas Valley. Expect weak prices for the next two weeks, at minimum.



ONIONS

- Fresh-run onions are available in California and South Texas.
- Yellow and white varieties are meeting demand; red onions remain scarce, especially larger sizes.

CHILE PEPPERS

- Prices are slowly easing as new growing regions open on both coasts.
- · Serrano and poblano supplies remain snug.

CITRUS

- Small California lemons continue to tighten; the crop is dominated by large sizes.
- The California Navel orange season will wrap up in late May. California Valencia production has started.

TIPS FOR **SERVING** COLLARD GREENS



- Sauté RSS Collard Greens until tender and serve with mashed sweet potatoes and cornmeal-fried shrimp.
- Add RSS Collard Greens to slow-and-low braises like pork shoulder or beef brisket so they soak up the flavor-packed juices; serve as a side dish and/ or garnish.
- Fry RSS Collard Greens and RSS Sliced Onions in pork fat; deglaze with stock and simmer until tender, then stir in barbecue sauce. Great with ribs, potato salad, and pulled pork.

Chopped Collard Greens and Soba Noodle Salad

A cold preparation of our chopped collard greens in an Asian inspired, hearty and healthy, soba noodle salad.

4 C Ready-Set-Serve Chopped Collard Greens

1/2 C Markon First Crop Carrots, julienned

1/2 C Markon First Crop Red Bell Peppers, julienned

1/4 C English Cucumbers, julienned

8 each Ready-Set-Serve Washed & Trimmed Green Onions, sliced thin

1/4 C Ready-Set-Serve Washed & Trimmed Cilantro

12 oz. cooked buckwheat/soba noodles

1T sesame seeds, toasted

6 oz. rice wine vinegar

1 tsp. maple syrup

2 T ginger, grated

2 T tamari or soy sauce

2 tsp. sambal/chili garlic paste

1 T sesame oil

1/4 C canola oil

2 T creamy peanut butter

3 T water

Cook soba noodles according to directions on package and cool. Using a blender, add rice wine vinegar, tamari, maple syrup, sambal, ginger, sesame oil, and peanut butter. Blend, adding water, and then slowly add canola oil to incorporate. Set aside. In a bowl, combine chopped collard greens, vegetables, and noodles. Reserve green onions. Toss with dressing and mound on plate. Top with green onions and sesame seeds.
